**Subject:- Discontinuation of CLCS component of CLCS – TU scheme-

Madam/Sir,


As you are aware the Credit Linked Capital Subsidy scheme aims to facilitate technology up-gradation of MSEs through institutional finance for induction of well established and updated technologies in the specific sub-sectors/ products approved under the scheme.

2. Although the scheme was in operation since Financial Year 2000-2001, the scheme in its present form as a component of Credit Linked Capital Subsidy and Technology Up-gradation Scheme was approved by the Government on 13th February, 2019 with an overall scheme allocation of Rs 2360 crore for giving Capital Subsidy to eligible Micro and Small Units for the reference year 2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20. Thus, the CLCS component of CLCS-TU scheme was in operation till 31.03.2020 only.

3. Ministry of MSME has already released Rs 2360 crore earmarked for the CLCS component to the Nodal Banks and Agencies for settling the subsidy claims submitted by the MSEs. However, Ministry of MSME has also sought additional allocation for clearing the pending claims .

4. I am directed to advise that as in case of all other Central Sector Schemes of the Government of India, the Credit Linked Capital Subsidy Component of CLCS-TUS is presently under evaluation for its continuation in the next Finance Commission Cycle Period (2021-26). Final decision regarding continuation of CLCS would accordingly be considered on the basis of findings of the third party evaluation and completion of other administrative modalities.
