

Brief Industrial Profile of Barwani District

1. General Characteristics of the District

District **Barwani** was formed on **25th May 1998**. It was carved out of West-Nimar, Khargone district. Barwani is situated on the south-west side of Madhya Pradesh as well as holy river **Narmada** is its northern border. District is surrounded by **Satpuda** (in South) and **Vindhyachal** (in North) forest ranges.

The name **Badwani** originated from the forests of **Bad** which had surrounded the city in old times. **Wani** is the old word for the Garden. and hence city got its name **Badwani** which means Garden of Bads. Barwani is still pronounced as Badwani but it spells **Barwani**

Town **Barwani** was the capital of old **Barwani State** before 1948. This small State was spared by British, Mughals and Marathas because of its rocky terrain and less productive soil. The **Rana** dynasty ruled the state through the history. The history of this dynasty goes back to 13th century.

Before Independence **Barwani** was known as '**The Paris of Nimar**'

1.1 Location & Geographical Area.

District is situated between **Latitudes** 21°37' to 22°22' North and **Longitudes** 74°27' to 75°30' East. State of Maharashtra in South, Gujarat in far West, district Khargone on the East and district Dhar on the North from boundaries of Barwani. District is triangular in shape with the highest point in West.

The town **Barwani** is situated near the left bank of the Narmada River.

1.2 Topography

Barwami is western districts of Madhya Pradesh and is something like a triangular in shape.
