Brief Industrial Profile of District Basti

1. General Characteristics of the District

The city of Basti is situated in Eastern Uttar Pradesh, in between Ghaghara and Amy river, about 180 Kms east of Lucknow. Main crops of district are sugarcane, oilseeds, cotton, paddy, wheat etc. Kuvani River situated at 12 Kms north, Bhadeswar temple situated at 05 Kms south. This town has Fort of Amoda, Ganesh pindori state, Athdoma state and Narhana Pandey state. This town has one Polytechnic, three ITIs only and there is no University / Medical College / Engineering College.

1.1 Location & Geographical Area

Basti city is located in between Ghaghara & Amy river. Total area of Basti district is 2688 Sq. Kms. The latitude of Basti city 26.23 and 27.80 N and longitude of Basti city 82.17 & 83.2 E. It is surrounded by Siddhartha Nagar district in North, Sant Kabir Nagar district in east, Gonda in west and Faizabad district in south. The length of district from south to north 70 Kms and west to east 85 Kms. The headquarter of Basti district situated in bank of Kuwano river at National Highway No.28.

1.2 Topography

The topography of Basti district is comprises of Alluvial Soil, smooth & domat, sand, gravels. Entire district has plain land and flow of water north to east. The main rivers of district are Ghaghara, Manorama & Kuwano.

1.3 Availability of Minerals.

There are no minerals available in district Basti except sand which is extracted from rivers viz; Ghaghara, Kuwani and Manorama and used as building material etc.
