

BRIEF INDUSTRIAL PROFILE OF THIRUVALLUR DISTRICT-2015-16

1. General Characteristics of the District

Thiruvallur district, a newly formed district bifurcated from the erstwhile Chengalpattu district (on 1st January 1997), is located in the North East part of Tamil Nadu.

North Latitude between 12°15' and 13°15' East Longitude between 79°15' and 80°20'

Tiruvallur is a town located on the Chennai-Tirupathi highway, approximately forty-four kilometers from Chennai. The railway station falls mid-way between the Chennai-Arakkonam railway line. A small town, and now the district headquarter of the recently made Tiruvallur district is developing very fast. It is one of twenty-seven districts in Tamil Nadu. Previously, Tiruvallur was a town in the district named Chengalpattu.

Tiruvallur is the name of both the town as well as the districtThe district is surrounded by Kancheepuram district in the South, Vellore district in the West. Bay of Bengal in the East & Andhra Pradesh State in the North. The district spreads over an area of about 3422 Sq.kms. An insight into the early history of this region shows that the region was reined by kingdoms such as the Pallavas, the Golkondas, the Mughals, the French, the Dutch and also the British.

1.1 Location & Geographical Area.

The Coastal region is mostly flat while certain areas in Tiruttani and Pallipattu taluks are undulated and even hilly. The types of soil predominantly found are red non-calcareous and coastal alluvial. Also found sandy soil mixed with soda or other alkali. The soil found in the coastal region is of the erinaceous type (sandy), suitable for casuarinas plants.

1.2 Topography

The average rainfall of the district is 1104.4 mm, of which the North East monsoon contributes to the tune of 690 mm. The actual rainfall received during the agricultural year 2001 - 02 is 1164.4mm. The average temperature of the district is - Maximum 37.9°C and Minimum 18.5°C

Like other parts of Tamil Nadu, hot climate prevails during the month of April - May and humid climate during the rest of the year except December - February when it is slightly cold.

1.3 Availability of Minerals.



3. INDUSTRIAL SCENERIO OF THIRUVALLUR DISTRICT.

Thiruvallur district is one of the fastest developing districts in Tamil Nadu in terms of Industrial Development. The district has many leading industries like Madras Refineries, Madras Fertilizers, Manali Petro Chemicals, MRF, Ashok Leyland, TI Cycles, Britannia India Ltd, Parry India Ltd and Hindustan Motors. It also boasts of the

Ennore Thermal Power Station and the Avadi Tank Factory. The District has 16 Industrial Estates, all in operation: 11 developed by the Government and 5 by Private Organisation. This district also has 16940 Small Scale Industries.

Maximum units have been established in metallurgy (750 units) followed by computer and computer related activities (700 units). Manufacturing of machinery have also taken up a large share of



investment in the district. Other than these, industries relevant to construction materials like brick manufacturing, wood and paints are also available in this region.

There are 178 Large and 21 Medium Scale Enterprises and there are 27319 Micro and Small Enterprises engaged in the manufacturing of various products like Leather/Textiles/Chemical/ Engineering. Some of the economic activities undertaken by the rural artisans are manufacturing of jute, coconut shell products, and palm leaf based products, paper cups, leather, Rexine works etc

3.5 UDYOG AADHAAR MEMORANDUM (UAM)

Govt. of India, Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises(MSME) has notified the Udyog Aadhaar Memorandum(UAM) under the MSMED Act, 2006 vide gazette notification [SO No. 2576(E)] dated 18-09-2015 in order to promote ease of doing business for MSMEs. A one-page simple registration form for online filing of UAM has been introduced which replaces the filing of Entrepreneur's Memorandum Part I & II. The filing of UAM can be done on www.udyogaadhaar.gov.in .Registration is online and user-friendly. UAM can be filed on self-declaration basis. No documentation required. No Fee for filing. Can file more than one Udyog Aadhaar with same Aadhaar Number. EM-I has been abolished. Need not file through Udyog Aadhaar. Udyog Aadhaar (UA) is for running units. No need to apply for upcoming units
