

Brief Industrial Profile of Araria District

1. General Characteristics of the District

Araria is situated at the northern part of Purnia and Madhepura in Bihar. Borders of Araria are surrounded by Nepal in northern side, Kishanganj in eastern side and Supaul at western side. The district came into existence by division of Purnia district on Makar-Sankranti day of 1990. District border is adjacent to border of Nepal, so the district is important in terms of security. Jogbani is the last point of Araria and after that "Virat Nagar" district of Nepal starts. For transportation both train and road media's are available. Araria contains two bus terminals one at '0' mile and second in city. Buses for most of the districts are available and as well as for internal blocks too. Train facility is now in the form of broad gauge track. This track ends one side to the Katihar, which is a big and important junction from where trains to all over India are available, other end of track is Jogbani the last point of Indian rail.

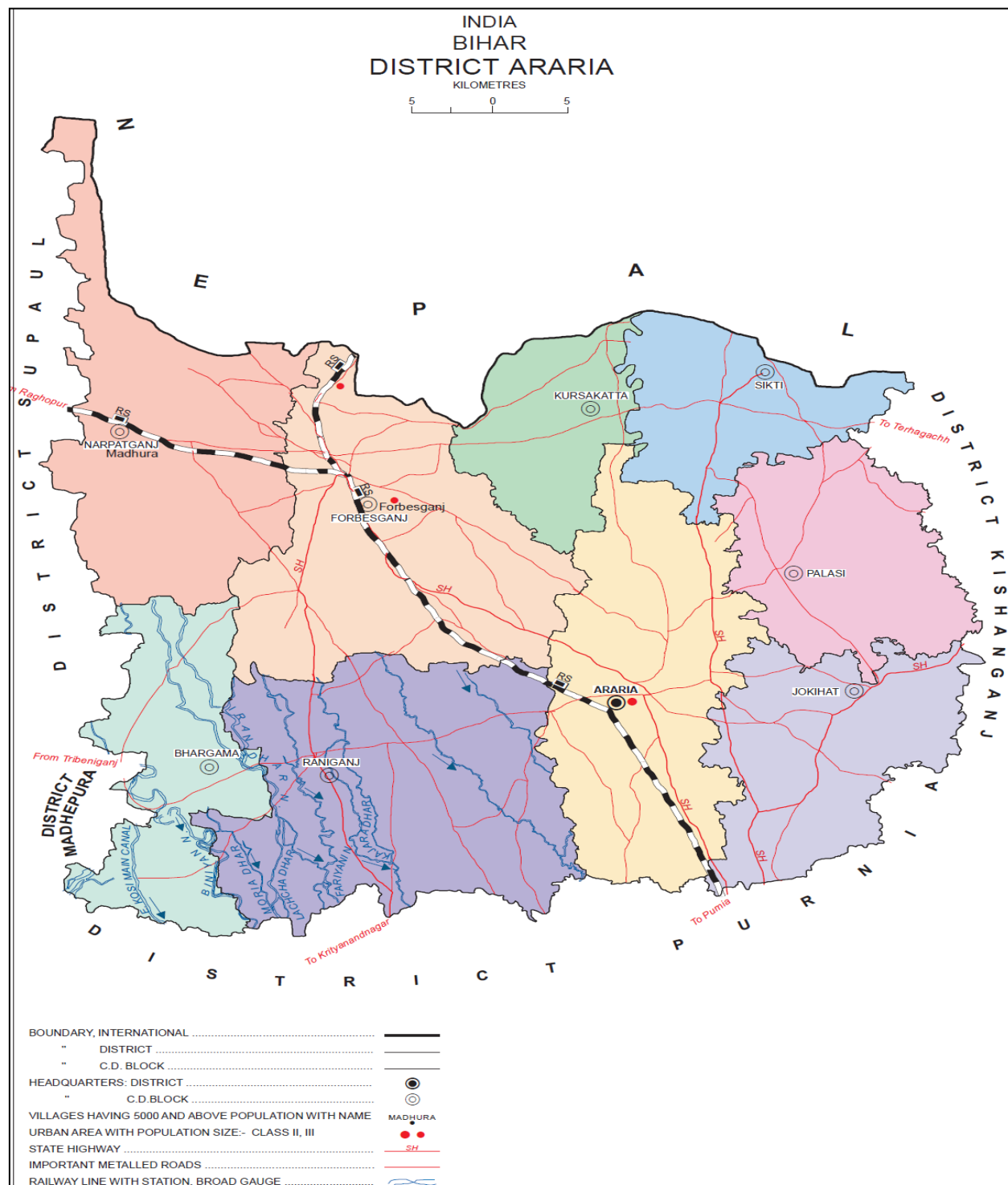
Forbesganj is a city, comes in the district of Araria in the state of Bihar, India. It has a prestigious past but enshrouded in the midst of uncertainties. Many stories have been widespread about it. Angas are believed to be the earliest inhabitants of the region. They are believed to inhabit in the area west of the river Koshi. During the Mauryan period this area formed the part of the Mauryan Empire and in the later times, the region formed the part of Gupta Dynasty. During the British period, the region came under the control of East India Company. It is said that where Mr. Forbe's Bungalow was located was called "Residential Area" which local people used to call as "R.Area". Over a period of time, "R.Area" acquired the pronunciation "Araria" and so the name of this sub-division as "Forbesganj".

1.1 Location & Geographical Area

The district Araria is located at latitude of 26 degree 13 minute North and longitude of 87 degree 47 minute East and is having an area of 2830 sq.km .The districts of Araria is surrounded by Nepal in the north, Purnea in the south, Kishanganj in the east and Supaul & Madhepura in the west.

1.2 Topography

The district is agricultural based area as the land is fertile leads to cultivation being the major activity in the district. The River kosi since 1954 always brings flood in the area and damages too.



1.3 Climatic Condition

The district has a moist humid climate. The winter season starts in October and lasts till February. January is the coldest month with the average normal temperature of about 5°C. March to mid June forms the summer months. The maximum temperature in April and May reaches about 46°C. Monsoon sets in the second half of June and lasts till September. This district receives higher rainfall and the average annual rainfall being experienced is 1195 mm. Eighty percent of the total annual rainfall is recorded during the monsoon period.

1.4 Availability of Minerals:

The geological formation of the district consists almost entirely of alluvium and there are no minerals of any importance.

1.5 Forest

The district of Araria has an area of 838 hectare under forest coverage. Some teak, sal, sakhua, sheesham, palas, pipal and semal trees are still found in the district between Araria and Forbesganj.

1.6 Electricity and Power

There is no power house located in this district. The district gets electricity from Barauni Thermal Power Station. There are 246 electrified villages in the rural areas of the district.

1.7 Administrative set up

Araria is one of the thirty-eight district of Bihar and for better administration the district has been further divided into two sub-division namely Araria (4 blocks: Araria, Bhargama, Siktiti & Raniganj) & Forbesganj (5 blocks: Kursakanta, Forbesganj,

Bhargama, Raniganj & Narpatganj). Raniganj and Bhargama are under the joint jurisdiction of both the sub-divisions.
