Brief Industrial Profile of Darbhanga District

1. General Characteristics of the District

Darbhanga is an oldest district of Bihar and situated in the heart of Mithilanchal region of North Bihar. This district is famous for its traditional Mithilanchal culture and Fish, Bettel & Makhana which is the part of all the festivals and ceremony of Darbhanga District.

1.1 Location & Geographical Area


The Geographical Area of Darbhanga is 2279 Sq km which is located at the centre of Latitude 25°42′-26°24′ North & Longitude 85°45′-86°23′ East. The district has very rich & fertile land. It makes to cross 3 rivers viz. Koshi, Kamla Balan & Bagmati. All the three rivers originate from Nepal and cause severe damages of human lives, wealth & live stocks during flood in rainy season.

They have been boom for the farmers also. As they have made the land very fertile. The climate is cooler and damper. The cold weather stars early in the first week of November and the hot weather begins towards the end of March and the rain from the later part of June. The maximum temperature reaches up to 43° Celsius. The average rain fall in the district is 1143 mm.

1.2 Topography

Climate of Darbhanga is dry and healthy. The summer season remains very hot. It receives 90 percent of rainfall from monsoon.

The average annual rainfall is 1142.3 mm. Its area is 2279 sq. km. The fertile soil of koshi and kamala supports variety of vegetation but devoid of forest. The flood is a common phenomenon bringing devastation in this region almost every year being the region in the low elevation zone. Muzaffarpur, Sitamarhi, Madhubani, saharsa and samastipur are its surrounding districts.



1.3 Climatic Conditions

The district has generally a humid climate except during summer which is rather dry. The winter season starts from November and Summer Season from March. The rainy season extends from June to September, October being the transitional month. January is the coldest month. Westerly winds and dust storms begin to blow in the second half of March. May is the hottest month when the maximum temperature reaches up to 42°c. The monsoon season begins in the second half of June and lasts until September and maximum annual rainfall falls during the monsoon season. With the cessation of rains the temperature falls and the climate becomes rather pleasant. The district gets some winter rains also.

1.4 Availability of Minerals:

The district is formed of thick alluvial soil. Beds of Kankar or nodular limestone of inferior quality are occasionally found. The riverbanks are generally made up of new alluvial soil formed by continuous deposit of silt by the rivers. Saltpeter is the only mineral found in the district.

1.5 Forest

The forests have almost completely disappeared. Sisu, Khair, Palmyra, Khajur, Mango, jack-fruit, Pipal and tamarind trees are still found.

1.6 Electricity and Power

The district receives its entire power supply from the Barauni Thermal Power Plant of the Bihar State Electricity Board. Government has been paying full attention to rural electrification and a large number of villages have been electrified. Domestic and commercial use accounts are the major quantity of the power consumption in urban areas while in the rural areas the main consumption of electrical power is for agricultural purposes. 935 Villages of the district are electrified.

1.7 Administrative set up

The district is headed by District Magistrate. Under him DDCs then ADMs are posted for looking after the general administration, development and land reformers. At every division there is sub divisional officer called SDO and in every block there is Block Development Officer called BDOs/COs and in every panchyat there is Panchyat Sevak.
