

Brief Industrial Profile of Katihar District

1. General Characteristics of the District


Katihar is one of the 38 districts in Bihar. It is one of the 4 districts of Purnea division. The head quarter of the district is Katihar. The district Katihar is situated in the plains of North, Bhagalpur district in the west, Sahebganj district in the south and West Bengal in the East. It was one of the subdivisions of the old Purnea. Paddy is the main agricultural crops. Jute and paper Mills is the main industry. Mahananda and Ganga is the main river.

1.1 Location & Geographical Area

Katihar district is situated in the plains of North Eastern part of Bihar State, surrounded by Purnea district (Bihar) in the north and the west, Bhagalpur district (Bihar) and Sahebganj district (Jharkhand) in the south and Malda district and Uttar Dinajpur district (Paschim Bengal) in the East.

1.2 Topography

The topography of the Katihar district has been very much affected by the floods of river Ganges, Mahananda and Koshi. The district has alluvial soil and due to deposit of sand-silt by rivers and soil in southern and the western part has become sandy. The land is slightly higher in the North and gradually slopping towards the south. The slop is gradual. There is no hill in the district except a small block in Manihari Block which is composed of nodular lime stone.



1.3 Climatic Conditions

The district generally has a most humid climate. The winter season starts from November to February and January is the coldest month with the mean minimum temperature below 8°C and the summer season starts from March and lasts till June. May is the hottest month when the maximum temperature reaches up to 43°C. The monsoon season begins in the second half of June and lasts until September and maximum annual rainfall falls during the monsoon season. The district gets some winter rains also.

1.4 Availability of Minerals

As such there is no mineral availability is there in the district under report. The district has no deposits of any specific minerals. There is a nodular limestone belt at a detached hill near Manihari called Chotapahar. According to Wellerius, it is an aggregate rock, composed of many small pebbles of nodules united by common cement. The calcareous rocks might be having its natural cementing quality. Sufficient sand is also available in the district.

1.5 Forest

District has a very small forest area. The forests are mostly disappeared in the district. The Principle trees are Sal, Sakhua, Teak, Shisham, Palas, Peeple and Semal in the district.

1.6 Electricity and Power

The district receives most of its power supply from the State Electricity Board through North Bihar Power Distribution Company Limited. Both the towns of the district, Katihar and Manihari have electricity. In the rural areas, the pace of electrification is comparatively slow. However, considerable attention is now being paid to rural electrification and villages are being electrified. Number of electrified village in this district is 312.

1.7 Administrative set up

Administrative Head of the District is District magistrate. Other senior official of districts, sub division, block, panchyat support the administration. The district comprises 3 Sub-Divisions: Katihar, Barsoi and Manihar. Katihar sub-division consists 16 blocks: Katihar, Korha, Falka, Sameli, Barari, Kursela, Pranpur, Hasanganj, Dandkhora and Mansahi. Barsoi sub-division consists 4 blocks: Barsoi, Kadwa, Azamnagar and Balrampur. Manihari sub-division has 2 blocks: Manihari and Amdabad.
