Brief Industrial Profile of AURANGABAD District

1. General Characteristics of the District:

1.1 Location & Geographical Area.

Aurangabad District is bordered by the districts of Nashik to the west, Jalgaon to the north, Jalna to the east, and Ahmednagar to the south. Aurangabad is the headquarters and principal city. The district covers an area of 10,100 km², out of which 141.1 km² is urban area and 9,958.9 km² is rural. Aurangabad district is a major tourism region in Marathwada. Aurangabad District is located mainly in the Godavari River Basin and partly in the Tapi River Basin. The district is located between 19 and 20 degrees north longitude, and 74 and 76 degrees east latitude.

1.2 Topography

The location of Aurangabad is on 74 to 76 degrees East longitude and 19 to 20 degrees North latitude forms the part of the vast Deccan plateau all of India.

1.3 Availability of Minerals: No minerals available in the district

1.4 Administrative set up.

Aurangabad districts has 9 Tehsils. At the district level, collector is the Administrative chief and at Tehsil level, Tehsildars are looking after the administration as per collector's instructions. For rural development chief executive officer of Zila parishad and BDOs at block level are in charge of the administration. Municipal Corporation for Aurangabad and Municipal council for other Tehsils are responsible for urban development of all the Tehsils.
