### **Brief Industrial Profile of Osmanabad District**

### 1. General Characteristics of the District

### 1.1 Location & Geographical Area.

The Osmanabad district lies on latitude of 17.35 to 18.40 degrees N and on longitude of 75.16 to 76.40 degrees E. The district lies in the southern part of state. Most of the district area is rocky while the remaining part is plain. The height of district is 600 mm above sea level. Most part of the district is surrounded by Small Mountain called "Balaghar", Bhoom, Washi, Kalamb, Osmanabad & Tuljapur Tehsil le in the range of this Balaghar Mountain. Some part of the major rivers like Godavari and Bhīma come under this district.

### 1.2 Topography

The location of Osmanabad is on Latitude Of 17.35 to 18.40 degree N and Longitude 75.16 to 76.40 degree E. The district occupies an area of 7512.4 km². The district is surrounded by following districts: Solapur - South-west Ahmednagar - North-west Beed - North
