# **Brief Industrial Profile of Dantewada District**

### 1. General Characteristics of the District

The present Dantewada district has come into existence in 1998. Previously it was a part of Bastar district, therefore it consists of all the Bastaria features. Dantewada derives its name from the capital town of the district, named after the presiding deity of the town "Maa Danteswari'.

### 1.1 Location & Geographical Area.

Dantewada district is located between 18 D-56'-8" N latitude and 81 D-20'-37" E longitude. The total area of the district is 549712 hectares. The average rainfall of the district is 5468.1 mm.

### 1.2 Topography

Dantewada district is the part of Bastar Platue and has got all the topographic features of this platue.

## 1.3 Availability of Minerals.

Iron ore is the main mineral found in the district. Minor minerals like stone, murram etc. are also found.
