Brief Industrial Profile of Singhbhum(West)District

1. General Characteristics of the District

West Singhbhum district came into existence when the old Singhbhum District bifurcated in 1990. With 9 Community Development Blocks Eastern part became the East Singhbhum with Jamshedpur as its district Hqr. and with remaining 23 C.D.Blocks West Singhbhum with Chaibasa as its district Hqr. In 2001 West Singhbhum again divided in two parts. With 8 Blocks Saraikela-Kharsawan district came into existence. At present West Singhbhum remain with 15 blocks and two administrative Sub-divisions. The district is full of hills alternating with valleys, steep mountains, and deep forests on the mountain slopes. The district contains one of the best Sal forests and the SARANDA (seven hundred hills) forest area is known world over. Scenically it is beautiful with water holes and also contains wild life like Elephants, Bison, rarely found tigers & panthers, bear, wild dogs, wild pigs. Sambhar, deer and spotted deer are also found but their numbers are decreasing in the forests adjoining habitation. There are two accounts relating to the origin of the name of the district. According to one the name Singhbhum, or the lands of "SINGHS" has been derived from the patronymic of the Singh Rajas of Porahat. The second account suggests that the name is a corrupt form of the SinghBonga the Principal deity of tribal population of the district.

1.1 Location & Geographical Area.

West Singhbhum district forms the Southern part of the newly created Jharkhand State and is the largest district in the State. The district spread over 21° 58' AND 23° 36' north latitude and 85° 0' & 86° 54' East Longitude. The district is situated at a height of 244 Meter above the sea level and has an area of 5351.41 Sq. Kilometers. The district is bounded on the North by the district of **Khunti** , on the East by **Saraikela-Kharsawan** district, on the South by keonjhar, Mayurbhanj and Sundargarh districts of Orissa and on the west by the district of Simdega and Sundargarh(in Orissa)

1.2 Topography

The district spread over 21° 58' AND 23° 36' north latitude and 85° 0' & 86° 54' East Longitude.

1.3 Availability of Minerals.

The greater part of West Singhbhum district is covered by the iron-ore series. The following minerals are found in the district:

1.4 FOREST: out of total area of 535141 hectares 53% of area i.e. 283624 hectares is covered by the forest.

1.5 Administrative set up. From administrative point of view the district West Singhbhum has been divided into three Sub Divisions viz. Sadar Chaibasa, Porahat Chakradharpur and Jagannathpur. At present West Singhbhum remains with 16 blocks.

The district comprises 16 blocks: Chaibasa, Khuntipani, Jhinkpani, Tonto, Kumardungi, Tantanagar, Jagannathpur, Manjhari, Manjhgaon, Noamundi, Chakradharpur, Bandgaon, Manoharpur, Goilkeria, Sonua and Hatgamharia. The district contains large deposits of iron ore which are increasingly being mined to feed the growing demand for steel production.

3.6 Growth Trend: The growth trend is rising upward ever since the district has been carved out of Singhbhum. The number of units has been increasing. However, the dearth of land with Adityapur industrial area development Authority, which provides basic amenities to the units, inhibits the growth trend. Lack of infrastructure another inhibiting factor in the growth trend. Announcement of State Industrial policy; 2012, is likely to boost up growth trend of industries in Singhbhum West in particular and entire state in general. Price of land in Industrial Area Development Authority is exorbitantly high and so not many new units are coming up.

3.7 Vendorisation / Ancillarisation of the Industry: Almost all the units are Ancillary to TATA Motors, and other large scale units around Adityapur industrial area development Authority.

Nations first Special Economic Zone (Automobile and Auto Components) at Industrial Area Gamharia (It is to be noted that the Adityapur Industrial Area Development Authority which falls under Singhbhum East is adjacent to Industrial Area Gamharia which falls under Sarikela Kharsawana. For all Practical purpose they are considered to be the same disregarding the district boundaries.), has also been visualized and consequently it was inaugurated by Hon'able Chief minister of Jharkhand on 16th November 2005.
