Brief Industrial Profile of karimganj District.

1. General Characteristics of the District: Karimganj District is located in the Southern tip of Assam-a state in the North eastern corner of India. Together with two neighbouring District-Cachar & Hailakandi, it constitutes the Barak valley Zone in Southern Assam. Total Area of the District is 1809 Sq. Kms, which comprises varied geographical features like agricultural plains, shallow wetlands, hilly terrains & forests. Total forest cover of the District is more than 54,504 hactare. That is about 30% of the total geographical area covered by forest.

<u>LOCATION & GEOGRAPHICAL AREA</u>: The geographical location of the Karimganj District in between longitudes 92 15 & 92 35 East and latitudes 24 15 & 25 55 North. The District is bounded on the North by Bangladesh & cachar District, on the South by Mizoram & Tripura State, on the West by Bangladesh & Tripura and East by Hailakandi District. Total Geographical area of the District is 1809 Sq.Kms.

TOPOGRAPHY: The District topography shows the positional features of the District, showing its Border with various states and district located in the North Eastern part of India. The Prime geographical character that form the topographical features of Karimganj District, a part of Barak valley, The river spreads its alluvial plains across the Length and Breadth . The paddy field of the district are specially blessed by the river. being divided into several rivulets & streams, the river as a whole makes the land suitable for agricultural production. Adding the alluvial soil, river directly helps in increasing the crop growth.

1.4 FOREST: The total forest cover of the district is more than 54,504 hectare. The forest comprises of 48057.303 hectare of reserved forest & 6489.09 hectare of proposed reserve forests. The total forest area does not include unclassified state forests

1.5 <u>ADMINISTRATIVE SET UP</u>; Karimganj is one of the 27th District of Assam,headed by Deputy Commissioner ,it Comprises only one Sub-Division,which is also names as karimganj.Below this level there are 05 Revenue Circle (Tehsils) namely Karimganj,Badarpur,Nilam Bazar,Patharkandi & R.K.Nagar,Furthermore from the Development angle,the District is divided into 07 C.D Block-North karimganj,South Karimganj,Badarpur,Patharkandi,R.K.Nagar,Dullavcherra, & Lowairpoa.Below the Blocl level set up there are 96 Gaon Panchyat each comprising about 10 villages on the average and governed by local Self bodies.
