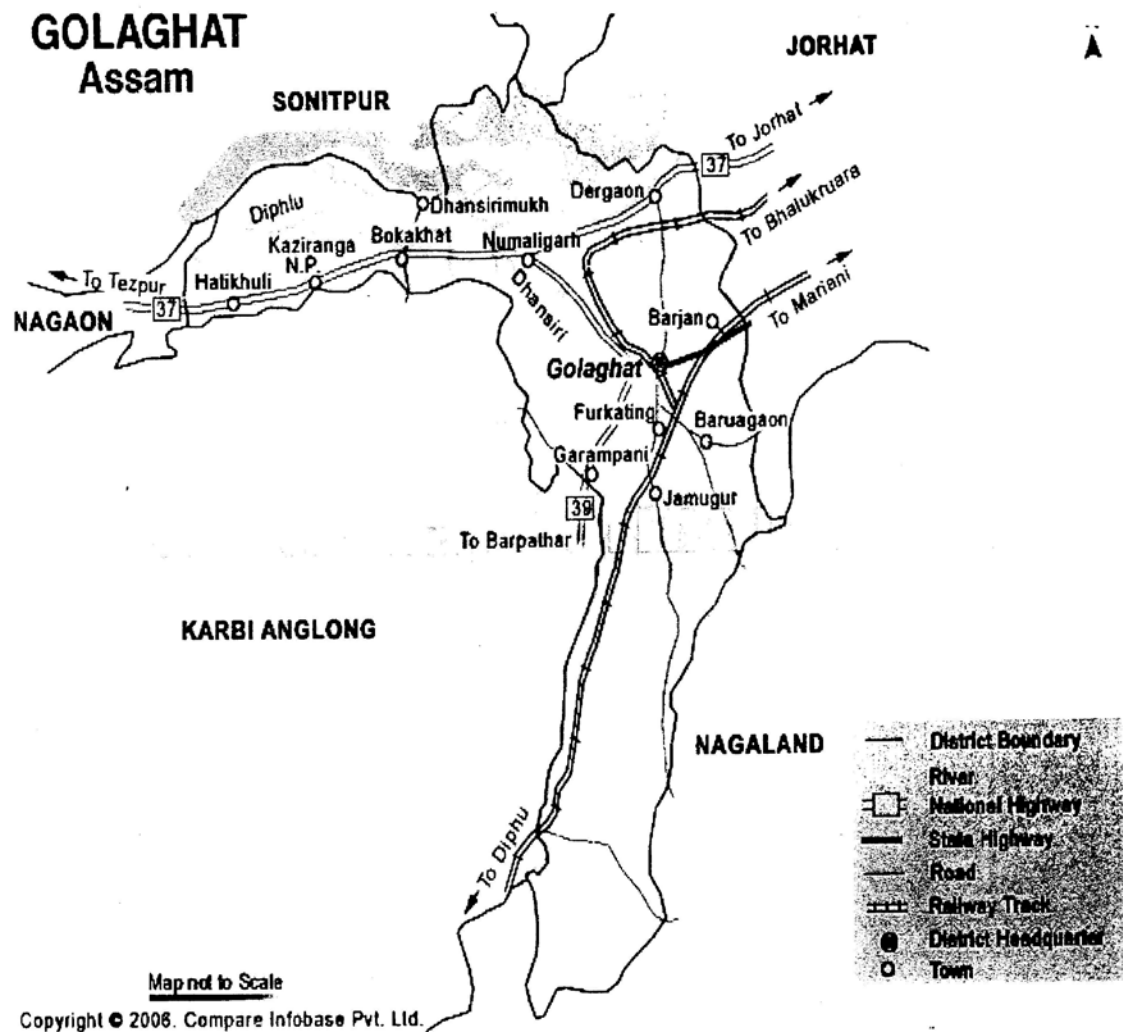

Brief Industrial Profile of Golaghat District

1. General Characteristics of the District

Golaghat gets its name from the shops of the Marwari community members who settled their business at the bank of river Dhansiri near Golaghat town during mid 20th century. Golaghat is a combination of two words that ‘Gola’ means shop & ‘Ghat’ meaning the leading point of river ferry. The district is also the gateway to Kaziranga National Park.

The Golaghat District has extreme climate with large variation of temperature from season to season as also from day to night. The highest temperature recorded is 38 deg. C and lowest at 10 deg. C. The rainfall is received mainly from southwest monsoon during the period from May to August. The district falls within medium rainfall zone of Assam state having average rainfall of 1300 m.m.

Golaghat district is covered by alluvial soil comprising of clay, silt, sand gravel and pebbles. The soil is well drained by a number of perennial streams/tributaries of the Brahmaputra. The district has a large no of ‘beels’ and ponds which are potential sources of surface water. The major rivers of the district are Brahmaputra, Dhansiri, Kakodonga, Doyand, Gelabil and Diplolu.

1.1 Location & Geographical Area.

Golaghat district is surrounded by the river Brahmaputra to the north, the state of Nagaland to the south, Jorhat district to the east and Karbi Anglong and Nagaon district to the west. Golaghat district stretches an area of 3502 sq.km. Area under urban sector is 31.52 sq. Km. while the area under rural sector is 3470.48 sq.km. In terms of area, district Golaghat constitutes 4.46% of the total area of Assam state.

1.2 Topography

The climate of Golaghat District is tropical with a hot and humid weather existing in most of the summer and monsoon months. The average annual rainfall of this region is 1300 mm. Maximum rainfall occurs in the months of June and July. The maximum temperature of the district is 38 degree Celsius in June and minimum temperature is 10 degree Celsius in the month of December. Wind direction is from northwest to southeast. Further, the vast geography of Golaghat District also includes tropical evergreen and semi evergreen forest; tropical grassland in Kaziranga National Park and swampy vegetation. The flora and fauna of Golaghat District are rich and diverse. Nambor Reserve Forest is very rich in plant diversity. Rare and endangered plant species are found in this forest. Further, the fauna of this region is rare and varied too. Besides the one horned Rhino, Swamp Deer, Water Buffalo and Indian Elephant of Kaziranga National Park, Golaghat District harbours various other endangered wildlife such as Turtle and Tortoise, Butterflies, Honeybee, Great Indian Hornbill, Bengal Florican, White wing Wood Duck, Hoolak Gibbon, Pigtail Macaque, Slow loris, Chinese Pangolin, and much more. Thus, it can be said that the geography of Golaghat District is subjugated by huge range of tropical forests comprising endangered species.

1.3 Availability of Minerals

Golaghat district have only minor mineral resources such as soil, sand, Murom and bolder.

1.4 Forest

Total area of the forest in Golaghat district is 3502 sq.km. Major forest area located at Kaziranga, Doyang, Nambor, Rengma(part), Diphu(part).

Golaghat district has a total forest area of 108974 ha. Forming 31.12% of the total geographical area. The famous Kaziranga sanctuary spread over an area of 46000 ha. Is situated in the district. The forest is rich in variety of tree species used for furniture. Plywood, Railway sleepers, Electricity, Telephone poles, etc. The tree species are Holong, Khokan, Sopa, Nahar, Simau, Gamari etc. totaling about 100 species of which about 35 species can be commercially exploited.

1.5 Administrative set up.

Golaghat is an administrative district of Assam with headquarters located at Golaghat town. The district is bounded by the river Brahmaputra on the North, state of Nagaland on the South, District Jorhat on the East and Karbi Anglong & Nagaon district of Assam on the West. The district has been divided into 3 Sub Divisions (Golaghat, Bokakhat, Dhansiri H.Q.- Sarupathar) and 8 Blocks for the purpose of administrative convenience namely Golaghat East Development Block - H.Q.- Padumoni, Golaghat West Development Block - H.Q.-Bokakhat, Golaghat North Development Block - H.Q.-Dergaon, Golaghat South Development Block - H.Q.-Sarupathar, Golaghat Central Development Block - H.Q.-Kathalguri, Kokodonga Development Block - H.Q.-Sitalpathar, Gamariguri Development Block, Morongo Development Block - H.Q.-Purabangla with 102 Gaon Panchayats.
