# **Brief Industrial Profile of Upper Siang District**

#### 1. General Characteristics of the District:

Upper Siang District is one among 17 Districts of Arunachal Pradesh State, India. Upper Siang District Administrative head quarter is Yingkiong. It is Located 250 KM South towards State capital Itanagar. Upper Siang was bifurcated from East Siang district with Yingkiong as its headquarters. Upper Siang is a district in the State of Arunachal Pradesh in India with a veritable treasure house of nature in its full splendor. The district has 11 Administrative Circles with a total population of 35,320 of which male and female were 18,699 and 16,621 respectively. It is inhabited by Adi, Memba, Khamba and Idu Mishmi tribes who have been harmoniously living in the cradle of nature since time immemorial with colorful festivals / rituals like Solung, Aran, Reh, Lossar, Dihang, etc.

It is a mountainous region endowed with rich natural resources and biodiversity, deep gorges and fast flowing streams and rivulets, which form the tributaries of the mighty **Siang River**. It flows through the district running into Indian Territory at a point near **Gelling** in the Indo-China border.

There have been radical changes over the years on all developmental fronts. However, the long isolation and inaccessibility of the areas due to communication bottlenecks pose formidable constraints to the efforts for socio-economic developments

#### 1.1 Location & Geographical Area:

The district headquarters are located at Yingkiong. Upper Siang district occupies an area of 6,118 square kilometers (2,362 sq mi). The district is bounded by Tibet, the Mac Mohan Line in China in the North, East Siang district in the South, Upper & Lower Dibang Valley districts in the East and West Siang district in the West. The district is the location of the massive Upper Siang Hydroelectric Project.

#### 1.2 Topography:

Upper Siang district is a mountainous tract in Arunachal Pradesh which covers approximately between 7032 sq. km. of area, at latitude between 27.45"N and 28.13"N and longitude 93.13"E and 94.36"E. The main river of the district is the Subansiri originating from the Tibet (China) besides innumerable rivulets.

Upper Siang has forest under National Park having 483 Sq. Km. & unclassified forest area of 686 Sq. Km.

#### 1.5 Administrative set up:

Deputy Commissioner (DC) is the Administrative Head of the district who is aided by sub-ordinate level Administrative Officers like Addl. Deputy Commissioner (ADC), Extra Assistant Commissioner (EAC), Circle Officer (CO), etc along with HODs (Head of Department) of various departments. The Administrative Units below the level of the district are based on the clusters of certain entities like circles, villages, households, etc .There are three sub divisions in Upper Siang district, namely, Yingking, Mariyang & Tuting , which is further divided into 11 circles A total of 5 Community Development Blocks which are headed by BDOs. There are two Arunachal Pradesh Legislative Assembly constituencies in this district: Tuting-Yingkiong and Mariyang-Geku. Both are part of Arunachal East Lok Sabha constituency.
