Brief Industrial Profile of Salem District

1. General Characteristics of the District

The Date of human civilization in this district reaches far back to the stone ages. The existence of prehistoric culture in Salem is evident from the discovery of Paleolithic and Neolithic stone implements and dung ash heaps in and around Salem. Salem District was bifurcated into Salem and Namakkal district (2-Feb-1997). Salem constituted 8 Taluks - Salem, Yercaud, Attur, Omalur, Mettur, Sankari, Gangavalli, and Idappadi and Namakkal district constituted 4 Taluks - Namakkal, Tiruchengode, Rasipuram and Paramathi-Velur

1.1 Location & Geographical Area.

Salem is a Geologist's paradise, surrounded by hills and the landscape dotted with hillocks. Salem has a vibrant culture dating back to the ancient Kongu Nadu. As a district, Salem has its significance in various aspects.

1.3 Availability of Minerals.

The district is rich in mineral deposits like Magnesite, Bauxite, Granite, Limestone, Quartz and Iron ore.

1. **MAGESITE** :The Most prominent deposit of Magnesite is located in Chalk hills of Salem over an area of 17 Sq. Kms and estimated to be 44 million tonnes. This is used by Burn & Co, TANMAG, TATA Refractories, Dalmia and Ramakrishna Magnesite for the manufacture of dead burnt Magnesite and calcined Magnesite.

2. **BAUXITE:**In Shevaroy Hills of Yercaud taluk, Six Bauxite occurrence are known in Semmaduvu, Manjakuttai and Puliyur villages. The Bauxite is being exploited by MALCO for their aluminium plant at Mettur Dam.
3. **LIMESTONE:**The crystalline limestone or Precambrian age are main occurrence in Sankari Taluk which are exploited for the production of Cement by India Cements Limited, Sankari west.
4. **IRON ORE:**Iron ore deposits in Salem District are very extensive though of low grade. The deposits are lie in Kanjamalai and Goodamalai area.
5. **QUARTZ AND FELDSPAR:**Quartz and Feldspar deposits are reported in various places in Sankari, Omalur, Mettur and Edppady taluk.
6. **SOAPSTONE:**Soapstone occurs as an alternative product of ultramafic rocks at a number of places from Periyasoragai, Aranganur, Tholasampatty, Marakottai and Kongupatty of Omalur Taluk.
7. **DIMENSIONAL STONES:** Dolerite dyke rocks (Black granite) are occurred in various parts of the district. Paithur, Seeliampatty manjini, Umayalpuram in Attur Taluk, Yellikaradu, Sampalli Kannamoochi and Anthiyur in Mettur Taluk. The Colour granites are occurred in Edappadi which are extensively quarried for building ornamental purposes.
8. **BUILDING STONE:** Charnockite is locally uses as building stones and road matalas.
