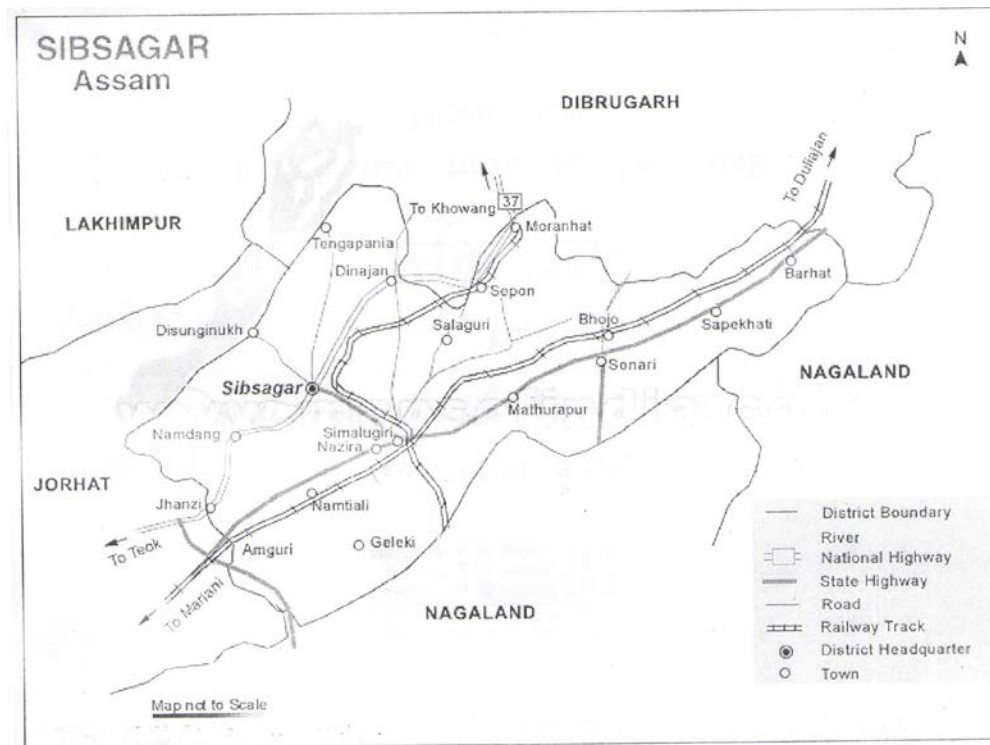

Brief Industrial Profile of Sivasagar District

1. General Characteristics of the District

Sivasagar is a famous historical place. The literal meaning of Sivasagar is the ocean of Siva- Strew with tall tale ruins of powerful Ahom kingdoms. Sivasagar district stretches an area of 2668 sq km.

The population of the district as per Economics & Statistics department in the year 2011 was 109877. Literacy percentages in the district are 93.67% in male & 90.11% in female.

The climate of the district does not differ much from the other Brahmaputra valley districts of the state of Assam. The district enjoys a moderate and pleasing climate with cool and foggy winter and generally hot & humid summer. The wet session stretches from April to September during which period the district receives heavy rainfall. The Brahmaputra has a moderate influence on the climate; hence it is mildly hot in summer with maximum temp. of 40°C and bearably chilly in winter with a minimum temp. of around 8°C. Due to the abundance rainfall, humid atmosphere and favorable soil condition the land is very much conducting for agriculture.

The charaideo hills tracts in the central part of district. Except Charaideo hills the whole district is a vast level plain covered with evergreen forest, bamboo, fruit and tea bushes and vast paddy fields.

1.1 Location & Geographical Area.

The Sivasagar District is located between 94°25' E to 95°25' E longitude and 26°45' N to 27°15' N latitude. The district is bounded on the North by the lakhimpur and Dibrugarh districts, on the East Dibrugarh district and Arunachal Pradesh, on the south Nagaland state and on the west Jorhat district. The geographical area of the district is 2668 sq km including 25343.477 hect. forest area.

1.2 Topography

The district is situated in the humid sub-tropical region and characterized by heavy rainfall and high relative humidity above 90%, high temperature upto 38°C is observed in the summer season and comparatively low temperature upto 7°C in rabi season. Average annual rainfall during 2004 was 1448.09 mm. Higher amounts of rainfall received during June-September and scanty but evenly distributed rainfall during the rest of the months. Wind speed is quite low i.e. 3.0 km/h. Bright sunshine hours during the months of November to January are longer which is favourable for crop growth and yield but scanty water due to less rainfall may affect the crop growth.

1.3 Availability of Minerals

Sivasagar district have major resources such as Petroleum (crude) & Natural gas and minor mineral resources such as soil, sand, Murom and bolder.

1.4 Forest

Total area of the forest in Sivasagar district is 25343.477 hectares and reserve forest area is 21950.477 hect. There are many important spices of timber available in forest of the district.

1.5 Administrative set up.

The present Sivasagar district was covered out from the old Sivasagar district. Before 1st July 1983 it was a sub-division of old undivided district. The present Sivasagar district is consist of three sub-divisions namely Sivasagar (Sadar), Nazira and Charaideo. The district consist of 3 development blocks, 875 villages 118 Gaon panchayats, seven towns and 16 police stations. There are six Assam Legislative Assembly constituencies in this district: Nazira, Sivasagar, Sonari, Amguri, Thowra and Mahmara. All these six constituencies are in the Jorhat Lok Sabha constituency. Most of the development activities are controlled by Deputy Commissioner, of the District.
