Sanction of the President of India is hereby conveyed to release of payment amounting to Rs. 2,46,67,518/- (Two Crore Forty Six Lakh Sixty Seven Thousand and Five Hundred Eighteen only) under GIA-General of RAMP- MSME Champions Scheme (Lean, Design, ZED, Incubation, IPR, Digital MSME) EAP for Implementation of Design Component of MSME Innovative Scheme, a component of MSME Champions Scheme to Central Tool Room (CTR), Ludhiana (as CNA of RAMP Scheme) w.r.t. approval in 3<sup>rd</sup> PMAC meeting held on dt. 27.9.2022 for the FY 2022-23.

2. The details of Design Projects/Student Projects and the respective amount approved in 3<sup>rd</sup> PMAC and 40% for design projects and 50% for Student projects of the amount as 1<sup>st</sup> installment as per scheme guidelines are attached at **Annexure-A**

### 3. Roles and Responsibilities of CNA:

Central Tool Room (CTR), Ludhiana shall release the amount to the respective Implementing Agencies (IAs) as per the **Annexure-A**, after submission/upload all requisite documents. The Grant-in-Aid will be regulated in accordance with the OM of Dept. of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance vide No. 1(18)/PFMS/FCD/2021 dated 9<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 (copy attached) regarding revised procedure for flow of funds under Central Sector Schemes and provisions contained in the Design Component of MSME Innovative Scheme. CTR, Ludhiana has been nominated as CNA vide letter dated 13.09.2022 issued by RAMP division of this Ministry (*copy of the order enclosed for reference*). CTR, Ludhiana shall strictly follow the roles and responsibility as mentioned in the aforesaid O.M. The funds released are also subject to the provisions contained in Chapter 9 of the General Financial Rules, 2005, as amended from time to time, read with the Government of India's decisions incorporated there-under and any other guidelines which may be issued in this regard and in particular to the following conditions:


- i) CTR, Ludhiana shall maintain CNA account of Grant-in-Aid received from the Government and utilized. In addition, as per the detail separate bank account mentioned at para 9 would be maintained under the central plan Scheme monitoring system (CPSMS) of the Ministry of Finance.
- ii) The grant shall be utilized for the purpose of development of Design/Student Projects under Design Component of MSME Innovative Scheme as provisioned in the Scheme guideline. Further, while incurring the expenditure, austerity measures should be taken into account as issued from time to time by competent authority.
- iii) CTR, Ludhiana shall maintain a register of permanent and semi-permanent assets acquired if any, wholly or mainly out of the above grant in the prescribed format and copy thereof should be furnished to this Ministry.
- iv) If any capital assets created in the CTR, Ludhiana, DC (MSME) will be the sole proprietor of the same. Assets acquired wholly or substantially out of Government Grant shall not be disposed of without obtaining the prior approval of the sanctioning authority of Grant-in-aid.
- v) The accounts of CTR, Ludhiana shall be open for inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Controller & Auditor General of India under the provision of C&AG (DPC) Act, 1971 in accordance with the provisions laid down in Section 14 of the C&AG (DPC) 1971) as amended from time to time and Internal Audit party of the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSME), whenever it is called upon to do so.
- vi) The grantee shall submit the Utilization Certificate in the prescribed form GFR-12 duly signed by the Head of the Institution/ Grantee latest by 31.03.2023. The utilization certificate in respect of grants should also disclose whether the specified, quantified and qualitative targets that should have been reached against the amount utilized were in fact reached, and if not, the reasons therefor furnished by concerned IAs.
- vii) CTR, Ludhiana shall furnish an Audited Statement of Accounts of the financial year before 30.04.2023 also indicating separately Activity-wise and Head-wise expenditure.
- viii) Grant-in-Aid shall be utilized subject to the Economy and other Instructions issued from time to time by the M/o Finance or by the Competent Authority.
- ix) CTR, Ludhiana shall certify that the utilization certificates due for submission for the Grants-in-aid sanctioned in the previous year's containing all the relevant details under GFR 212(1) have been submitted to the satisfaction of the Ministry of MSME.

- x) CTR, Ludhiana shall adhere to all the relevant provisions of GFR and any other instructions/ guidelines issued by the Government from time to time, while making procurement/ purchases of goods and services including compliance to GFR provisions in case of out-sourcing of services and engagement of consultants.
- xi) CTR, Ludhiana has been exempted from execution of the bond. CTR, Ludhiana shall, however, furnish an undertaking that it will comply with all the terms and conditions stipulated in the sanction order.
- xii) CTR, Ludhiana should send pre-receipted bill and undertaking to agree to the terms & condition of this sanction (in triplicate) to this Ministry for payment of the amount drawn against this sanction.
- xiii) In no case the grant released under this sanction will be utilized for any purpose other than those indicated in the sanction. The grantee shall not divert the grants and entrust execution of the Scheme or work concerned to another Institution or Organization and shall abide by the terms & conditions of the grant and follow/ adhere to all the relevant provisions of GFR regarding Grants in aid. If the grantee fails to utilize the grant for the purpose for which the same has been sanctioned or does not adhere to the terms & condition of Grant and GFR provisions, the grantee/Institution shall be required to refund the grant with interest @10% per annum, if any.
- xiv) CTR, Ludhiana will send the detailed progress report of fund utilized by Implementing Agencies under Design component of MSME Innovative Scheme under MSME Champions Scheme.
- xv) CTR, Ludhiana may use the fund as prescribed in the Scheme guidelines of Design component of MSME Innovative Scheme relating to development of Design/Student Projects. The expenditure under the sanction is maximum, saving if any, will be surrendered to the Govt. of India.
- xvi) The grantee institution shall not utilize the interest earned if any on the recurring/non-recurring grants-in-aid released to the institution for any purpose.

#### 4. Roles and Responsibilities of Implementing Agencies (IAs) under Design component:

- i. As this is the 1st installment, IA will utilize this GoI grant for completion of Stage 1 of the project as per scheme guidelines. On successful completion of the Stage 1, IA will submit the Audited actual exp. report (head wise as per Annexure – C of the application form of guideline) along with UC & refund the balance GoI amount if any.
- ii. IA will utilize the GoI & MSME Contr. proportionately. No funds out this grant will be released to the MSME. IA will provide all the necessary support as per the requirement of the project.
- iii. No machinery/ tools/ equipments will be purchased from this grant. These can be hired on rental basis as and when required on need basis.
- iv. IA will submit the monthly progress report along with photos to this office.
- v. IA shall certify that it has not obtained/ applied for any grant for the same purpose/ activities from any Central/ Ministry/ State govt.
- vi. IA will ensure that the Project is completed within the time frame of the scheme guidelines. Upon the completion of the project, IA will submit a completion report and will demonstrate the prototype product before the PMAC.
- vii. IA shall not divert any part of the grant to any activity other than for which it has been sanctioned.


