2. This is in accordance with the Department of Expenditure's OM no. 3(17)/PFMS/2022 dated 5<sup>th</sup> September, 2023 (**copy enclosed**) which has provided following relaxations/advice:

i. Relaxation from validation check put in PFMS granted to MoMSME till 31st December, 2023 to generate sanction orders in PFMS for token amount not exceeding Rs. 1 (one) in each case. Once the sanction order is issued, CNA can assign adequate financial limit to the project in PFMS to enable utilization from the amount balance in the CNA account concerned.

ii. For redistribution of limits assigned to various sub agencies, MoMSME may follow the procedure prescribed in DoE's OM No. 3(04)/PFMS/2022 dated 5<sup>th</sup> July, 2023 (**copy enclosed**).

2.1 This Sanction Order gives effect to the MoF's advice as per Para-2 (i) above.

**Special Guidelines in accordance with DoE's OM no. 3(17)/PFMS/2022 dated 5th September, 2023 (ref. para-2.1 above):**

4.1 There will be no correlation with the bank balance lying in the CNA bank account and the assignment of financial limits by the PD, MSME to the CNA and/or by the CNA to the SAs (IAs).

4.2 The Programme Division (PD), MSME will enhance the drawing limit of the CNA by the 'Sanctioned' amount mentioned in this Sanction Order.

4.3 Central Tool Room and Training Centre (CTTC), Bhubaneswar, Odisha (CNA) shall assign the financial limits to the respective IAs as per the 'Sanctioned' amount mentioned against each of the IA above as per the scheme guidelines.

4.4 The CNA shall promptly intimate the Ministry once the actual bank balance in the CNA Bank Account reaches the level of **Rs. 1.70 crore** [approx. 6.25% of the budget of Rs.27.00 crore earmarked for the CNA (CTTC, Bhubaneswar) in the FY 2023-24], so that fresh fund release out of the 'Sanctioned' amount of this Sanction Order can be processed and released.

**General Guidelines:**

4.6 The Grant-in-Aid will be regulated in accordance with the OM of Dept. of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance **vide No. 1(18)/PFMS/FCD/2021 dated 9<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 (copy attached)** regarding revised procedure for flow of funds under Central Sector Schemes and provisions contained in the Design Component of MSME Innovative Scheme. CTTC, Bhubaneswar, Odisha has been nominated as CNA vide letter No. 41(1)/Budget/MSME Champions/2021 dated 27.06.2022 for MSME Innovative of MSME Innovative Scheme of MSME Champions Scheme (**copy of the order enclosed for reference**). **CTTC, Bhubaneswar** shall strictly follow the roles and responsibility as mentioned in the aforesaid O.M. The funds released are also subject to the provisions contained in Chapter 9 of the General Financial Rules, 2005, as amended from time to time, read with the Government of India's decisions incorporated there-under and any other guidelines which may be issued in this regard and in particular to the following conditions:

- i) CTTC, Bhubaneswar shall maintain CNA account of Grant-in-Aid received from the Government and utilized. In addition, a separate Bank account shall be maintained for the Government Grants under this Scheme. (The bank account should be same which was authorized for operation at the time of registration under the central plan Scheme monitoring system (CPSMS) of the Ministry of Finance).
- ii) The grant shall be utilized for the purpose of conducting Awareness Programme under Design Component of MSME Innovative Scheme as provisioned in the Scheme guideline. Further, while incurring the expenditure, austerity measures should be taken into account as issued from time to time by competent authority.
- iii) CTTC, Bhubaneswar shall maintain a register of permanent and semi-permanent assets acquired if any, wholly or mainly out of the above grant in the prescribed format and copy thereof should be furnished to this Ministry.
- iv) If any capital assets created in the CTTC, Bhubaneswar, DC (MSME) will be the sole proprietor of the same. Assets acquired wholly or substantially out of Government Grant shall not be disposed of without obtaining the prior approval of the sanctioning authority of Grant-in-aid.
- v) The accounts of CTTC, Bhubaneswar shall be open for inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Controller & Auditor General of India under the provision of C&AG (DPC) Act, 1971 in accordance with the provisions laid down in Section 14 of the C&AG (DPC 1971) as amended from time to time and Internal Audit party of the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSME), whenever it is called upon to do so.
- vi) The grantee shall submit the Utilization Certificate in the prescribed form GFR-12 duly signed by the Head of the Institution/ Grantee latest by 31.03.2024. The utilization certificate in respect of grants should also disclose whether the

- specified, quantified and qualitative targets that should have been reached against the amount utilized were in fact reached, and if not, the reasons therefor furnished by concerned IA.
- vii) CTTC, Bhubaneswar shall furnish an Audited Statement of Accounts of the financial year before 30.04.2024 also indicating separately Activity-wise and Head-wise expenditure.
- viii) Grant-in-Aid shall be utilized subject to the Economy and other Instructions issued from time to time by the M/o Finance or by the Competent Authority.
- ix) CTTC, Bhubaneswar shall certify that the utilization certificates due for submission for the Grants-in-aid sanctioned in the previous year's containing all the relevant details under GFR 212(1) have been submitted to the satisfaction of the Ministry of MSME.
- x) CTTC, Bhubaneswar shall adhere to all the relevant provisions of GFR and any other instructions/ guidelines issued by the Government from time to time, while making procurement/ purchases of goods and services including compliance to GFR provisions in case of out-sourcing of services and engagement of consultants.
- xi) CTTC, Bhubaneswar has been exempted from execution of the bond. CTTC, Bhubaneswar shall, however, furnish an undertaking that it will comply with all the terms and conditions stipulated in the sanction order.
- xii) CTTC, Bhubaneswar should send pre-receipted bill and undertaking to agree to the terms & condition of this sanction (in triplicate) to this Ministry for payment of the amount drawn against this sanction.
- xiii) In no case the grant released under this sanction will be utilized for any purpose other than those indicated in the sanction. The grantee shall not divert the grants and entrust execution of the Scheme or work concerned to another Institution or Organization and shall abide by the terms & conditions of the grant and follow/ adhere to all the relevant provisions of GFR regarding Grants in aid. If the grantee fails to utilize the grant for the purpose for which the same has been sanctioned or does not adhere to the terms & condition of Grant and GFR provisions, the grantee/Institution shall be required to refund the grant with interest @10% per annum, if any.
- xiv) CTTC, Bhubaneswar will send the detailed progress report of for fund utilized by IAs.
- xv) CTTC, Bhubaneswar may use the fund as prescribed in the Scheme guidelines of Design component of MSME Innovative Scheme relating to design and development of prototypes as per scheme guidelines. The expenditure under the sanction is maximum, saving if any, will be surrendered to the Govt. of India.
- xvi) The grantee institution shall not utilize the interest earned if any on the recurring/non-recurring grants-in-aid released to the institution for any purpose. The interest earned shall be indicated in UC which can be either adjusted in next release or to be refunded to Go I after grants-in-aid sanctioned is utilized.

**Terms and conditions for all IAs to organize Awareness Programme/ Workshops:**

- i. The fund shall be utilized for the purpose of conducting awareness programme only. The allocated awareness programmes would be completed during FY 2023-24.
- ii. The IA should inform the date, details of venue, programme topics along with speaker details to this office in advance
- iii. Minimum 30 to 50 nos. of participants in Awareness Programme must be ensured and efforts should be made for participants from SC, ST, OBC, PH, women & minority categories of MSMEs.
- iv. IA should ensure that all the programmes should be conducted at different locations especially in areas having proximity to Industrial hubs/ MSME Clusters.

- v. All IAs should involve MSME DFOs (erst while MSME DIs office) and Industrial Associations in their respective state for conducting the Awareness programme. IAs should share all the programme details i.e date venue etc to the MSME DFO in advance. One MSME DFO officer should be invited as guest speaker in the programme.
- vi. IA should invite reputed & subject specific speakers in the programme. Special arrangements may made for the MSMEs to register in the scheme
- vii. All Covid-19 pandemic protocol, other related issues would be followed (in case of such situations-and physical programme would be avoided), as issued by State /UT/ Govts. from time to time.
- viii. The expenses towards rent for venue, training materials, photography, audio/video aids, honorarium to the Guest Faculty, expenditure on purchase of stationary items, refreshment and other miscellaneous expenses should follow the Govt. of India, GFR rules and any other Govt. of India, Dep. Of Expenditure instructions/orders regarding economy in expenditure issued time to time. Government assistance is only for organizational expenses of the proposed event and not for capital items like equipments.
- ix. Further, while incurring the expenditure austerity measures should be taken into account as issued from time to time by competent authority.
- x. All the payments should be made through PFMS. The detailed report and feed back report of the awareness programme must be submitted to this office within 15 days after completion of the programme, along with photographs attendance sheet, no. of registration done, , suggestions etc. as per the attached format.
- xi. IA will submit a Audited expenditure report along with UC with 15 days after the completion of Awareness Programme.

6. DDO of the office of DC (MSME) will act as Drawing and Disbursing Officer for this sanction.


**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

Subject: Revised procedure for flow of funds under Central Sector Schemes – Relaxation sought by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (M/o MSME) regarding MSME Innovative scheme.

The undersigned is directed to refer to the Secretary, M/o MSME DO letter No. 6(19)/SanctiontoCNA/Incubation/2022-23 dated August 23, 2023 on the above mentioned subject. In this regard, a meeting was held with officers of M/o MSME on 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2023.

2. Considering that significant balance of Rs. 11.8 crore is available in the bank account of CNA, request of M/o MSME to provide relaxation from DoE's guidelines dated 9<sup>th</sup> March 2022 to release more funds to the CNA account is not agreed to. However, as discussed in the meeting on 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2023, following relaxations/clarifications regarding the aforesaid scheme are provided –

- i. Relaxation from validation check put in PFMS is granted to M/o MSME till 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2023 to generate sanction orders in PFMS for token amount not exceeding Rs. 1 (one) in each case. Once the sanction order is issued, CNA can assign adequate financial limit to the project in PFMS to enable utilization from the amount balance in the CNA account concerned.
  - ii. For redistribution of limits assigned to various sub agencies, M/o MSME may follow the procedure prescribed in DoE's OM No. 3/(04)/PFMS/2023 dated 5<sup>th</sup> July, 2023 (copy enclosed).
