**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

**Subject: Clarification Regarding Requirement of Current Account for Reimbursement under PMS Scheme**

It has come to notice that some MSME-DFOs are insisting on submission of a **Current Account** by MSEs as a precondition for processing reimbursement claims related to their participation in trade fairs/exhibitions under the PMS Scheme.

2. In this regard, it is clarified that **there is no such requirement under the PMS Scheme Guidelines**. MSEs may have either a Savings Account or a Current Account, and **reimbursement should not be withheld or delayed** on this ground.
3. All DFOs are, therefore, advised to strictly adhere to the scheme provisions and refrain from insisting upon a current account from MSEs for claim settlement.
4. This issues with the approval of the competent authority.
