## **Brief Industrial Profile of Dima Hasao District.**

**1 GENERAL CHARACTERISTIC OF THE DISTRICT:** The Dima Hasao District is situated at Southern part of Assam in the North East Region of India. The total area of the district is 4890 Sq.Kms. The major part of the ditrict is covered by the hills.The main range is Borail which “Thumjang”is the heighst peak at 1866 meter & Hempeupet is the second heighst peak at 1748 meter.The other main range is Khartheng range from Dittokcherra to Garampani.The total forest cover of the District is 63777.40 hectare.

**LOCATION & GEOGRAPHICAL AREA :**The Geographical location of the Dima Hasao District in between longitudes 92 37 and 93 17 East & latitudes 25 3 and 25 47 North.The district is bounded on the North by Karbi-Anglong & part of Nowgaon district,on the south by Cachar District of Assam,on the east by Manipur & part of Nagaland state on the west by Meghalaya & another part of Karbi-Anglong district.

**TOPOGRAPHY:** District topography shows the positional features of the District, Showing its border with various states and district located in North Eastern part of India.The prime geographical character that form the topographical features of Dima Hasao District . The major portion of the district is covered by hills.The main range is “**Borail** ” of which Thumjang” is the highest peak of 1866 meter & Hempeupet is the 2<sup>nd</sup> highest peak of 1748 meters. The other main range is “**khartheng**” range .

**Forest :** The total forest area of the district is 63777.40 hectare & entire area comes under reserve forest. The total forest area does not include unclassified State forest.

**ADMINISTRATIVE SET UP :** The Dima Hasao Autonomous District Council (DHAC) was constituted under the provisions of the 6<sup>th</sup> schedule to the constitution of India to administer this autonomous district. The development & administration has been conducted by Autonomous council, there are 28 MDCs areas and they represent as local bodies at grass root level selected on public franchise like PRI representative in plain district. In 1970 N.C. Hill was separated from the United N.C. Hills & Mikir Hills & declare full fledged district. Dima Hasao Autonomous District Council (DHAC) has three wings of administration viz, Legislature, Judiciary & Executive. Apart from the subjects enshrined in the sixth Schedule, the Govt. of Assam have transferred almost all the department along with Executive power to the council except General Administration, Police, Treasury, election and Judiciary.

Dima Hasao comprises of Two Sub-divisions viz Haflong and Maibang. There are Two Revenue Circles (Tehsils) viz Haflong & Maibang. In order to provide better Developmental facilities the district has been divided into five Community Development Blocks- Jatinga valley Development Block, Harangajao ITDP Block, Diyung Valley Dev. Block, Diyungbra ITDP Block, New- Sangbar Dev. Block.
