Brief Industrial Profile of Shivpuri District

1. General Characteristics of the District

Shivpuri district has a total area of 10,278 square kilometers, with a total population of 1,725,818 people as of the 2011 census. The district mostly consists of small hills and forests.. Most of the economy of the district is agriculture-based, with an estimated 83.38% of the working population engaged in agricultural endeavors, either as cultivators (70.40%) or agricultural laborers (12.98%). The main cereal crops being produced in the district are rice, maize, barley, wheat and jowar. The main pulses are gram and tur. The rest of the crops include sugarcane, condiments, spices and linseed

1.1 Location & Geographical Area.

Shivpuri is one of Madhya Pradesh's districts, located in the northern part of the state. To the north, the district is bounded by the districts of Morena, Gwalior and Datia while to the south; it is bounded by Guna district. The east of the district is already Uttar Pradesh, while to the west is Rajasthan
