1.1 Location & Geographical Area.

Dindori district is situated at the eastern part of Madhya Pradesh and touching Chhattisgarh state. Dindori district is bounded by Shahdol in east side, Mandla in west side, Umariya in north side and Bilaspur district of Chhattisgarh State in south side.

1.2 Topography-
