## **Brief Industrial Profile of Upper Dibang Valley District (Anini)**

1. **General Characteristics of the District:** Dibang Valley district is the land of the Idu Mishmis and Goddess Intaya, encompasses an area of 9129 Sq.km. bound by International border in the North-West, North and East with Tibet and China. The District Hq. Anini is located at an altitude of 1968 m with an area of 5 km radius. It is the most scenic District Hq. of Arunachal Pradesh located in the North-Easternmost corner of North-East India. It is connected by road as well as regular Pawans Hans Helicopter service from Dibrugarh. All basic amenities like taxis, telephone, electricity, Air-service, water supply, Internet, Cable TV, Post Office, Banks, Circuit House and I.B. are available round the clock at Anini.

**1.1 Location & Geographical Area:** Dibang Valley District is located in the North-Easternmost corner of Arunachal Pradesh with its main land standing in between 95°15'E and 96°35'E Longitudes, and 28°22'N 29°27'N Latitudes bound by international boundary in the North-West, North and East with Tibet and China. It is also bound by Lower Dibang Valley in the south and Upper Siang District in the south-west.

**1.2 Topography:** Dibang Valley is the largest district of Arunachal Pradesh with the lowest density of population in India. It has a temperate climate with lush-green mountains, heavy rainfall, dashing rivers, sparkling waterfalls, chirping birds, loitering wild animals and isolated Idu hamlets inhabited by people dressed in colorful costumes, singing, dancing and hunting but closely bound by centuries old customs, traditions and values.

**1.4 Forest:** The district is well known for its large cover of thick green forest, which clothes about 82% of the area. Mishmi Hills is situated in the Eastern Himalayan province, the richest bio-geographical province of the Himalayan zone and one of the Mega bio-diversity hotspots of the world.

The vegetation here can be classified into the following forest types: Tropical Evergreen, Tropical Semi-evergreen, Sub-Tropical Broad Leaved, Sub-Tropical Pine, Temperate Broad Leaved, Temperate Conifer, Sub-Alpine Woody Shrub, Alpine Meadow, Degraded, Bamboo, and Grasslands.

## 1.5 Administrative set up:

The Deputy Commissioner is the head of Upper Dibang Valley district. The administrative set up is based on single line administration which aims to keep close co-operation amongst various developmental departments with the district administration and thus, to work together for the speedy development of the area. The Deputy Commissioner being the overall in-charge of the district maintains law and order with the help of administrative officers and police.
