## **Brief Industrial Profile of Aizawl District.**

- 1 GENERAL CHARACTERISTIC OF THE DISTRICT: The Aizawl District is one of the eight district of Mizoram State in North Eastern part of India. The total Geographical area of the district is 3576.31 Sq.Kms, which comprises varied geographical features like agricultural plains, hilly terrains & forests. The total forest cover of the district is 273158 hectares. Aizawl is the state Capital of Mizoram which is about 1132 meter above sea level.
- 1.1 LOCATION & GEOGRAPHICAL AREA: The Geographical location of the Aizawl District in between longitudes 92°.30′-93°.00′ East & latitudes 23°.30′-24°.00′ North. The District is bounded on the North by Kolasib District on the West by the Mamit Distric on the North by Serchhip District and on the East by Champhai District The Geographical Area of the District is 3576.31 Sq.Kms
- 1.2 TOPOGRAPHY: District topography shows the positional features of the District showing its border with various states and district located in North Eastern part of India. The prime geographical character that form the topographical features of Aizawl District. The topography in general is undulant with broken mountain/hilly ranges and between them lies the Valley lands suitable for cultivation of field crops. The hills are situated for Horticultural practice where ever the slopes are gentle/moderate. The Soil in the hill are rich in humus due to forest cover. Though the district mainly comprises of hilly terrain there are low lying valley lands in few pockets, where altitudes is rather low having warm & humid climate facilitating paddy cultivation. The altitudes ranges between 100 meter to 1500 meter in the district.

- **1.4 FOREST**: The total forest area of the district is 273158 hectares out of which 1205 hectares dense forest & 2034 hectares open forest. Total forest cover of the district is about 76.37% of the total Geographical area.
- 1.5 ADMINISTRATIVE SET UP: Aizawl is one of the eight district of Mizoram, headed by the Deputy Commissioner. It comprises of 03 (three) Sub-Divisions which name as Aizawl (Sadar) Saitual, & Sakawrdai. Below this level there are 11 Revenue Circle (Tehsils) namely Sakawrdai ,Darlawn, Durtlang, Bawngkawn, Vaivakawn, Dawrpui, Tlangnuam, Aibawk, Thingsulthliai, Saitual & Phullen. Furthermore from the development angle the district is divided in 05 nos R.D Block –Aibawk, Darlawn, Tlangnuam, Thingsulthliah & Phullen. Below the Block level set up there are 91 nos of Village Council headed by Village council president. Aizawl town is the administrative headquarters of the district.
