**Brief Industrial Profile of Barwani District** 

1. General Characteristics of the District

District Barwani was formed on 25<sup>th</sup> May 1998. It was carved out of West-Nimar,

Khargone district. Barwani is situated on the south-west side of Madhya Pradesh and

Holy River Narmada is its northern border. District is surrounded by Satpuda (in South)

and Vindhyachal (in North) ranges.

The name Badwani originated from the forests of Bad which had surrounded the city in

old times. Wani is the old word for the Garden, and hence city got its

name Badwani which means Garden of Bads. Barwani is still pronounced as Badwani but

it spells Barwani.

1.1 Location & Geographical Area

District is situated between Latitudes 21°37' to 22°22' North and Longitudes 74°27' to

75°30' East. State of Maharashtra in South, Gujarat in far West, district Khargone on the

East and district Dhar on the North from boundaries of Barwani. District is triangular in

shape with the highest point in West. The town Barwani is situated near the left bank of the

Narmada River

1.2 Topography

Barwani is surrounded by the great hills of Satpura and in the rainy days it becomes one

of the most beautiful places in central India. The city is also called the Paris of Nimar.

The Nimar region is split into East Nimar and West Nimar. Nimar, in local terms, means

"area beyond the Neem Trees". Barwani lies in West Nimar. The annual rainfall of

Barwani is around 15 inches; Barwani is famous for its Papitas and Bawangaja (a Jain

holy place 8 KM from Barwani)
