Brief Industrial Profile of SUPAUL District

1. General Characteristics of the District

Supaul district is one of the thirty-eight districts of Bihar state, India, and Supaul town is the administrative headquarters of this district. This district occupies an area of 2,410 km² (931 sq mi). The district was carved out from the erstwhile Saharsa district on 14 March 1991. Not so far from the place supaul is the Indian border connecting NEPAL. Supaul,

Triveniganj, Birpur, Nirmali, Kishanpur, Saragar h-Bhaptiyahi, Pipra, Jagatpur, Garh-Baruari, Basantipur, Simrahi Bazar, Raghopur, Karjain, Pratapganj, Shyamnagar, Chhatapur, Jadiya, Parsarma, Bihra-patory, Motipur-Birdah, Laukaha bazaar Rajpurhat are well known places for its business.

Supaul has a rich history. The district of Supaul had been a part of Mithilanchal Since the vedic period. The area has been reffered to as the fishery area (Matsya Kshetra) in the hindu mythology. The oldest democracies namely Angutaran and Apadnigam are known for their existence in the Budhist era, which comprises todays area of district supaul. The river Kosi which is considered as the sorrow of Bihar, flows through the district

1.1 Location & Geographical Area.


Supaul is situated at 25 deg 37'-26 deg 25' N latitude and 86 deg 22'-87 deg 10' E longitude.

Supaul district comprises the following (4)Sub-Divisions:

Supaul, Birpur, Triveniganj and Nirmali

Supaul sub-division -consists of four blocks, namely, Supaul, Kishanpur, Saraigadh-Bhaptiyahi and Pipra. Birpur sub-division is further divided into three blocks- namely -Basantpur, Raghopur and Pratapganj. Triveniganj sub-division has two blocks, namely, Triveniganj and Chhatapur. Nirmali sub-division comprises two blocks, namely, Nirmali and Maruna.i.e. in total there are 11 blocks for the proper administration of the area of the district.
