BRIEF INDUSTRIAL PROFILE OF GHAZIABAD DISTRICT

1. GENERAL CHARACTERISTICS OF THE DISTRICT

The place Ghaziabad was founded by Ghaziuddin Siddiqi, Feroz Jung II great general of Mughal Emperor in 1740. Ghazi-ud-din Siddiqi Feroz Jung II was the elder son of Mir Qamaruddin Siddiqi first Nizam of Hyderabad, who called it Ghaziuddinnagar after himself and built a spacious structure consisting of 120 rooms of masonry with pointed arches. After the opening the railway line in the year 1864, the name of the place was shortened to Ghaziabad. As its boundary is adjacent to Delhi, it acts as the main entrance of Uttar Pradesh and that is why it is also called the Gate Way of Uttar Pradesh.

Ghaziabad was one of the Tehsils of Meerut District in Uttar Pradesh. Ghaziabad district was carved out of Meerut district on the 14th November 1976.

1.1 LOCATION & GEOGRAPHICAL AREA.

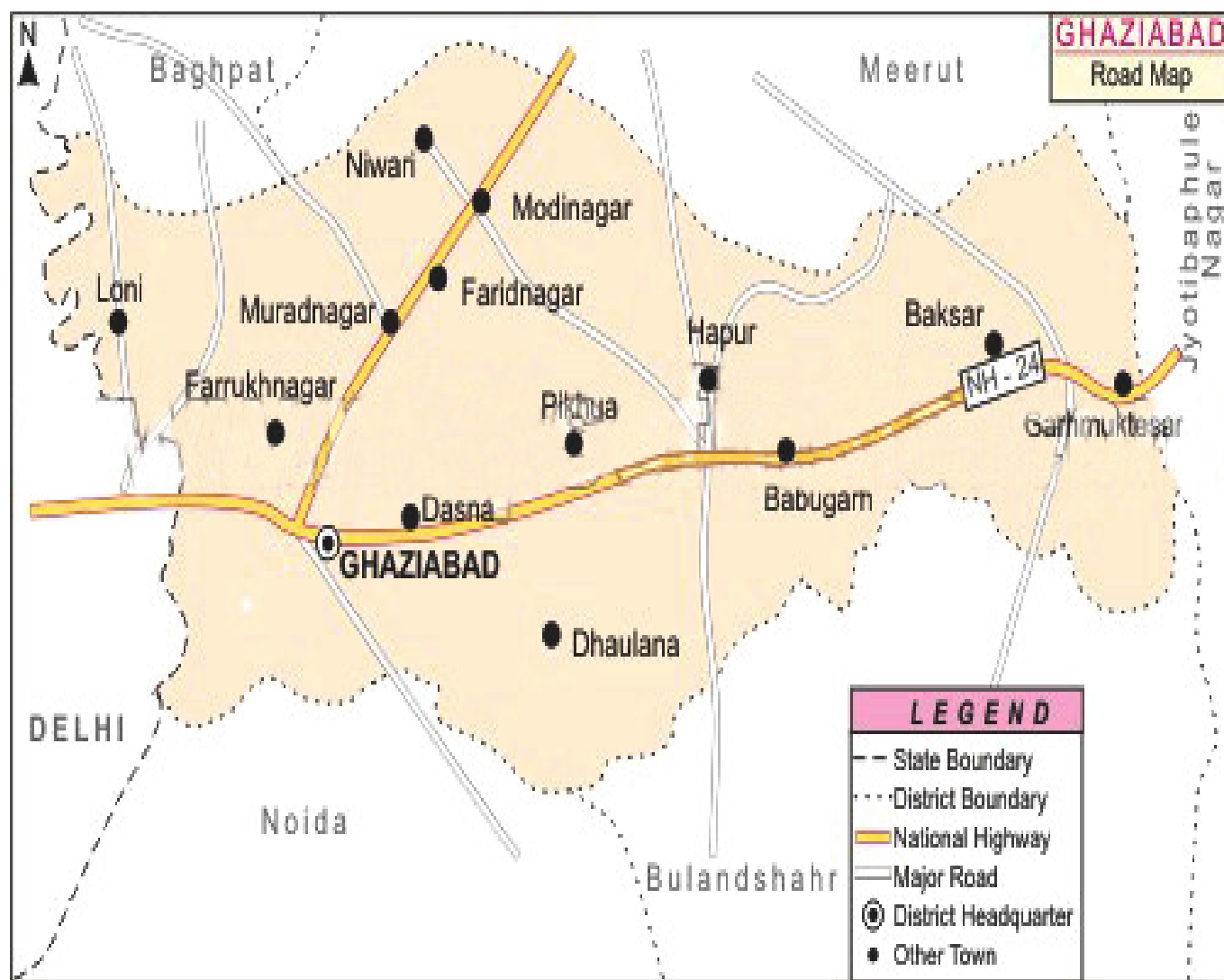
Ghaziabad is a large suburban district in state of UP in north India. It comes in NCR, It is the section of Meerut division. According to survey 2011 Ghaziabad is the third district in UP with highest population. The district Ghaziabad is situated in the middle of Ganga-Yamuna doab. In shape, it is roughly rectangular. Its length is 72 kilometers and its breath is 37 kilometers. It is located between 28°–30' and 28°-59' North latitude and 77°–26' and 78°-10' East longitude.

1.2 TOPOGRAPHY

Nature has been very generous to Ghaziabad. The land is very fertile; topography is plain and has abundance of good quality of groundwater. Besides the nature's generosity, the District has a tremendous locational advantage being in proximity to Delhi. Originally established on the eastern side of river Hindon, present sprawling development of Ghaziabad can be observed on both sides of river Hindon. Hindon River is an important tributary of Yamuna River & flows between Ganges and Yamuna rivers. Flowing north south, Hindon river passes through middle of the city and meets Yamuna about 35 KM south of Ghaziabad. District Ghaziabad is bounded by Meerut district on the north, Bulandshahr and Gautambudh Nagar districts on the south, Hapur on the east while Faridabad (Haryana) and National Capital Delhi State lies on the South West. The total area of the district was 2590 sq. km. But after dividing the district to form a new district namely Gautam Budh Nagar, it becomes 1148 sq. km.

1.4 FOREST

Forest area in the district is negligible. However, forestation is going on. Around 30 lakhs plantation is done with 100 percent achievement in the district. This will not only help pollution control to some extent in the district but also help industrial uses in the coming days.

1.5 ADMINISTRATIVE SET UP.

Ghaziabad district falls under the Meerut Division of U.P. It consists of five districts headed by Divisional Commissioner with its Headquarters at Meerut.

The Headquarter of the District is at Ghaziabad. For administrative purpose the district has been divided into 4 sub-divisions, 4 Tehsils and 5 Panchayat Samities.

There are 74 Gram Panchayats, 529 inhabited villages and 38 are uninhabited.

4 sub-divisions are:-

1. Ghaziabad.
2. Hapur.
3. Modi Nagar; and
4. Garhmukteshwar.

4. EXISTING CLUSTERS OF MICRO & SMALL ENTERPRISE

4.1 DETAIL OF MAJOR CLUSTERS

There is no cluster run by the institute. However some other agencies have started cluster on textile printing and fabrication of general engineering.

4.1.1 PROPOSED CLUSTER OF HANDLOOM RELATED INDUSTRY AT PILKHUWA

Weaving is a traditional handicraft to a large part of the rural sector of the Ghaziabad. Pilkhuwa Block is a concentrated place for weaving products. For people of Pilkhuwa area, it is a house hold industry. Due to weaving culture People of the area have the habitual skill to make their own clothes, of course, mostly by traditional methods. Khes, bed sheets, towels, durries/ lohi, tarpaulin etc. are manufactured. There is good demand of the items in the market.

Keeping this in view spade work is being made to start a cluster on Handloom related industry.

5. GENERAL ISSUES RAISED BY INDUSTRY ASSOCIATION DURING THE COURSE OF MEETING

1. Non recognition of EM-II acknowledgment by some of the state government agencies.
2. Bankers avoid to accept the cases under CLCSS due to lack of awareness among branch level bankers. There should be some mechanism for tracking of application status, so that the entrepreneurs get present status of their application
3. Bankers also avoid accepting the cases under Credit Guarantee Fund Trust for Micro and Small Enterprises (CGTMSE), especially for the new entrepreneurs and insisting for the collateral security.
4. There is lack of availability of timely credit. Entrepreneurs are facing difficulties in getting Bank Loan. Banks avoid accepting the cases under Credit Guarantee Fund Scheme especially for the new entrepreneurs.
5. Some of State Government Agencies /PSUs not recognize NSIC Certificates and insist for earnest money.
6. Deficiency of trained operators & service providers for manufacturing and service sector units.
